Version I.0

CODE OF CONDUCT

Each member and alternate member of the Executive Committee of the ZERO2NATURE system will:

1. Discharge his/her duties with honesty, integrity and full regard for his/her responsibilities as a Committee member.
2. Respect the confidentiality of all confidential information acquired in his/her position as a Committee member and not to make improper use of or disclose such confidential information to third parties.
3. Observe the principles of independence, accuracy and integrity in dealings with other Committee members, the ZERO2NATURE secretariat and ZERO2NATURE stakeholders.
4. Have no personal or direct financial interest in any matter under consideration by the Committee.
5. Exercise personal discretion in deciding whether she/he has a real or perceived conflict with respect to any matter under consideration by the Committee and disclose to the Committee any actual or perceived conflicts of interest of a direct or indirect nature of which she/he is aware and which she/he believes could compromise in any way the reputation or performance of the Committee.
6. Remain silent during the Committee's deliberations and decisions as to any matter under consideration by the Committee for which she/he has an actual or perceived a conflict of interest.
7. Maintain the principle of transparency in the preparation and delivery of information to other Committee members and ZERO2NATURE stakeholders.
8. Remain committed to observing, developing and implementing the principles embodied in this Code in a conscientious, consistent and rigorous manner.
